

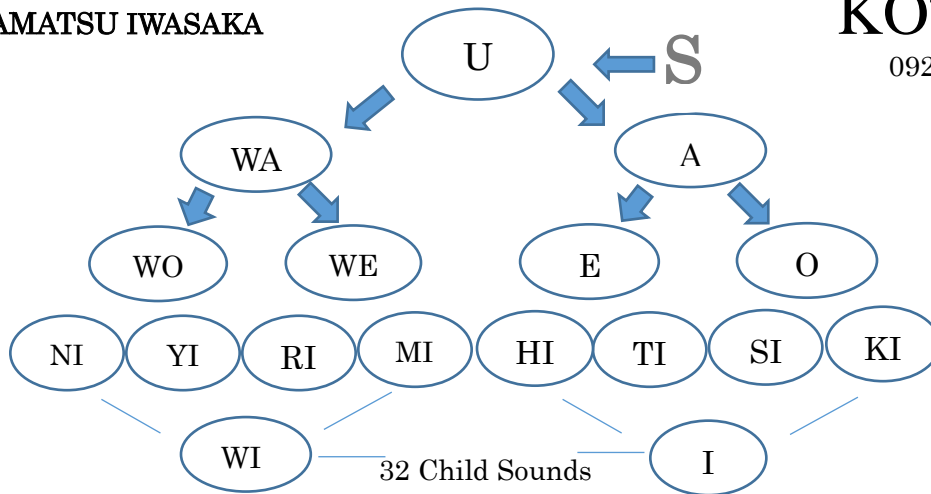

- 【T】 ✨ Devotion, concentration, and focus leading to an instantaneous beginning
- 【K】 ✨ Searching past experience; Going within to find stored knowledge.
- 【M】 ★ Seeking knowledge from the outside world
- 【H】 ✨ The beginning of clarity as light shows on darkness. Recognition before intellect
- 【R】 ★ Imagination. Exploration of ever-proliferating ideas; the movement is of a spiral traveling in a clockwise direction outward
- 【N】 ★ Nearing the conclusion – the culmination of work.
Like a pot of food, raw ingredients are becoming one dish
- 【Y】 ★ Exploring by staying the course.
Keeping the momentum by not changing the direction of the beginning
- 【S】 ✨ The calm coming from recognition and comprehension;
the movement is of a spiral traveling in a counterclockwise direction inward
