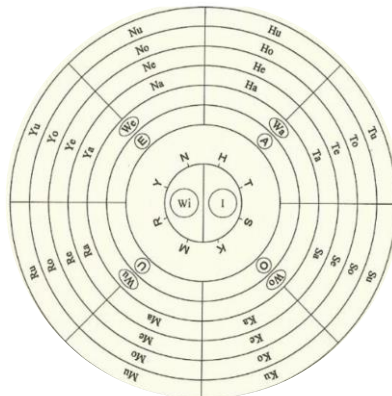
Hari is a highly refined form of Classical Japanese Meridian Therapy. Meridian Therapy focuses on treating the root cause of disease while also effectively treating the immediate symptoms through balancing the body's ki. Practitioners of this style train to develop an extraordinary ability to perceive ki through the practice of ki diagnosis, pulse diagnosis, and non-insertive needle techniques.

He has 45 years of Aikido experience, is an assistant professor at NESAs, and maintains a private practice in Watertown, MA.
